

Beer League Lacrosse, LLC Code of Conduct

The player code of conduct is essential to maintaining the culture of Beer League Lacrosse, LLC.

Players are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship at all times. Players are expected to respect the referees, their teammates, the table crew, and the opposing team players. Excessive arguing with referees, excessive questioning of referee calls, verbal or physical confrontations with players or referees, excessive use of force, and poor sportsmanship, or fighting may result in ejection from the game, multiple game(s) suspension, and possibly expulsion from all future Beer League Lacrosse, games, seasons, or events without refund.

Players who throw punches will be immediately ejected from the game. Additionally, a punches thrown event, will result in at least a subsequent 2 game suspension from Beer League Lacrosse, LLC. Any fighting event will be reviewed by the Conduct committee (5 players at large) who will make recommendations regarding disciplinary actions including additional game suspensions or expulsion from Beer League Lacrosse. Final disciplinary decision authority resides with Beer League Lacrosse, LLC Ownership.

Be level headed. If things are getting heated do any or all of the following, get yourself a substitution, talk to the referee, talk to the opposing player, talk to the opposing team captain. **DO NOT FIGHT. FIGHTING WILL GET YOU KICKED OFF BEER LEAGUE LACROSSE, LLC**
